Expert in Banking and Financial Services Law

The selected candidate(s) will be mainly responsible for giving legal advice on banking, payments and crypto assets regulation and supervision as well as other financial services topics within the EBA's scope. This includes, for example, advising on legislative requirements, drafting technical standards and guidelines, contributing to Q&As, investigating potential breaches of Union law, resolving disagreements between competent authorities, advising on supervisory independence.

Expert in Institutional Law

The selected candidate(s) will be mainly responsible for giving legal advice on institutional affairs including the EBA's governance, access to documents, Staff Regulations, host State relations, procurement.

Expert in Risk and Compliance

The selected candidate(s) will be mainly responsible for working with the Unit's Risk and Compliance team in implementing one or more of the EBA's risk and compliance frameworks covering risk management, ethics, anti-fraud and data protection.
